

1) Northeast Zone

- a) Continued work in Square XX99.
 - i) Goal = Clarify more of Cardo 4 to the north and a possible entrance into the garden to the west.
 - Basket = 2385 (Beisan jars; Indicative Wares: LRC; ARS; KFH; Mainly Dating from 400 CE- 700 CE)
 - iii) Starting elevation = 132.08
 - iv) Ending elevation = 131.81
 - v) Soil is tractor fill
 - vi) Removing corner high material. No evidence of W1297 or W1298.
- b) Continued work in Square YY0.
 - i) Goal = Identify the function of the space east of W1910, south of W1266, west of W1298
 - Basket = 2386 (Little pottery; mostly Beisan jars; small pieces; Indicative Wares: CRS; Residual: 1 KFH cooking pot; Mainly Dating from 400 CE- 700 CE)
 - iii) Starting elevation = 131.75
 - iv) Ending elevation = 131.43
 - v) Soil is horizon A.
 - vi) Pursuing W1913.
 - vii) Discovered a coin (#518) above W1913 at elevation 131.27, 0.95 from east edge of square and 4 m from north edge of square. It is a Roman Provincial coin of Elagabalus minted at Hippos in 218-219. The obverse has the bust facing right crowned with a laurel wreath. On the reverse is Pegasos standing facing left with the head turned back and the wings.



2) Southwest Zone

- a) Continued work in Squares E9/10.
 - i) Goal = identify the structure and function of Building Complex Alpha
 - ii) Basket = 2387 (Beisan jars; little pottery; Indicative Wares ARS, LRC; 450 CE 700 CE)
 - iii) Starting elevation = 130.28
 - iv) Ending elevation = 129.60
 - v) Soil is IDF fill with heavy blocks. May need to remove a meter of fill.
 - vi) Expanded square to the north into E9 in an attempt to acquire the south face of W1252.
 - vii) Then exposed some of the south surface of W1252
 - viii) There may be a poor quality north/south wall in the balk on the west side of E10.
 - ix) At the approximate level of the top of W1252 (elevation 129.99), a change in soil color (Horizon B) was noted
- b) Continued work in Square F10.
 - i) Goal = identify the structure and function of Building Complex Alpha
 - ii) Basket = 2388
 - iii) Starting elevation = 130.40
 - iv) Ending elevation = 129.65
 - v) Soil is IDF fill.

- vi) Very heavy mixed stones in dark soil. One cluster (2x6) of mosaic tesserae.
- vii) There may be a doorway in W1892 at the west border of F10.
- viii) Identified a north to south wall on the line of W1265 with a door jamb 4.73m from the north edge of W1252. The exterior of the door is to the east. The southern door jamb is not yet visible.
