- 1) Continued work in DQ40south
 - a) Goal = discover function of space east of window wall
 - b) Basket = 3425
 - c) Starting elevation = 131.01 (floor)
 - d) Ending elevation = 131.02
 - e) Soil = horizon b
 - f) Comments
 - i) Cleared most of the accessible floor
 - ii) Began to remove parts of the lifting platform
 - iii) The doorway to the central room was intentionally blocked
- 2) Continued work in DQ40NW
 - a) Goal = discover function of the space east of the window wall

- b) Basket = 3424
- c) Starting elevation = 132.60
- d) Ending elevation = 131.94
- e) Soil = horizon A
- f) Comments
 - i) Lowered one meter of the western side of the area (ramp) by 70 cm to create a lifting platform (enabling the removal of the current platform in DQ40S).
 - ii) Recovered two nails from the fill.
 - (1) Item 808
 - (a) Category: nail
 - (b) Material: metal, iron
 - (c) Shape: slight bend just below the head
 - (d) State of preservation: nearly complete, heavily rusted
 - (e) .5 cm width of shank
 - (f) 2.0 cm wide at head
 - (g) 6.5 cm length
 - (h) 2.0 m from East edge of DQ-40
 - (i) 2.5 m from north edge of DQ-40
 - (j) 3.0 m from west edge of DQ-40
 - (k) 2.5 m from south edge of DQ-40
 - (2) Item 809
 - (a) Category: nail
 - (b) Material: metal, iron
 - (c) Shape: nearly complete
 - (d) State of preservation: nearly complete, heavily rusted
 - (e) .5 cm width of shank
 - (f) 2.5 cm width of head
 - (g) 6.5 cm length
 - (h) 1.2 m from east edge of DQ-40
 - (i) .4 m from north edge of DQ-44

- (j) 3.8 m from west edge of DQ-40
- (k) 4.6 m from south edge of DQ-40
- iii) Removed stones in danger of falling from the balk.

3) Opened DR39

- a) Began cutting a trench in DR39 in an attempt to identify the eastern face of W1298. That face is unclear at the current depth.
- b) There may be later and higher walls going east from the line of W1298.
