

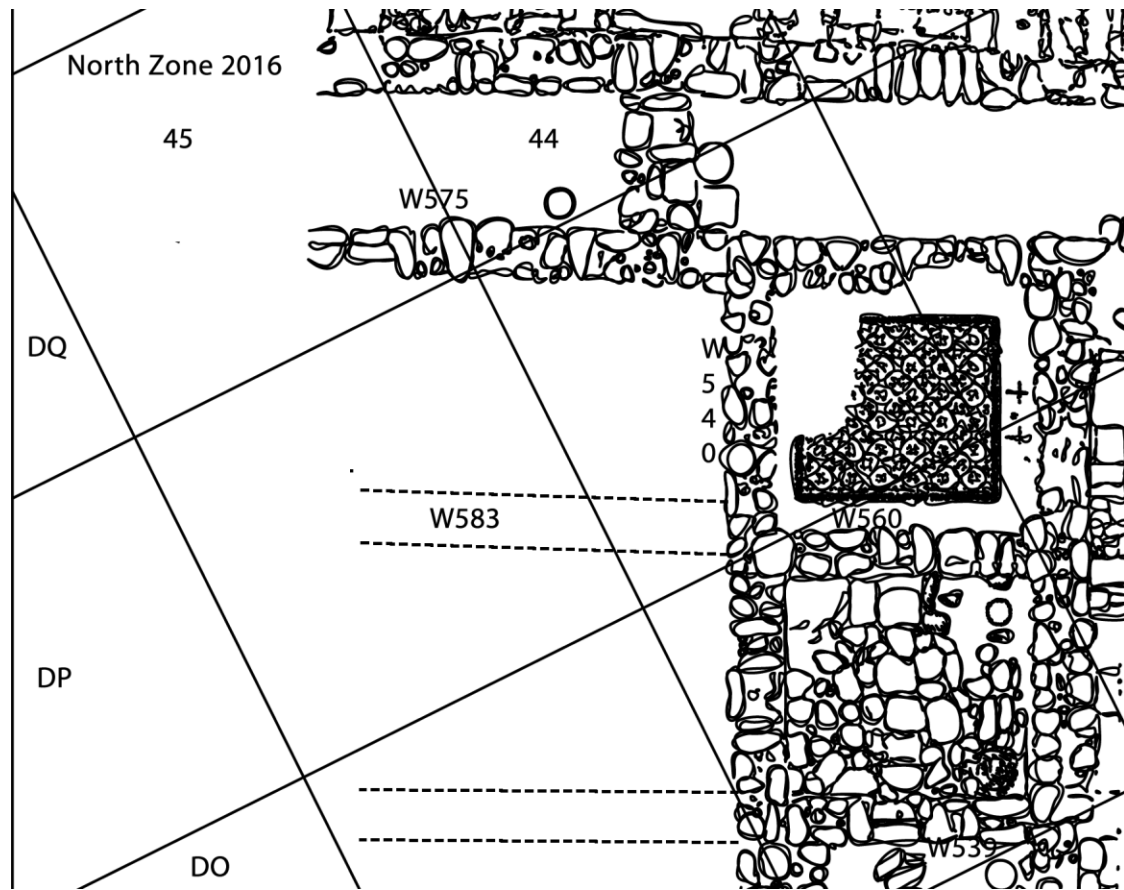

1. Continued/Began work in DP44
 - a. Goal = discover form and function of building north of the NEC
 - b. Basket = 3427
 - c. Starting elevation = 131.31
 - d. Ending elevation = 130.76
 - e. Soil = mostly tractor fill
 - f. Comments
 - Excavated to level of top of W583
 - Opened new locus below tractor fill (L2144)
 - Seems to be a pilaster in W583 about a meter north of W540. If it is a pilaster, it may mark an opening in W583.



2. Continued/Began work in DR40

- a. Goal = complete the excavation of the easterly storage room, east of the window wall W2132.
- b. Basket = 3428
- c. Starting elevation = 133.15
- d. Ending elevation = 132.40
- e. Soil = tractor fill
- f. Comments
 - i. Level area
 - ii. May be finding west side of W1298
 - iii. Some glass pieces of base of large bowl
