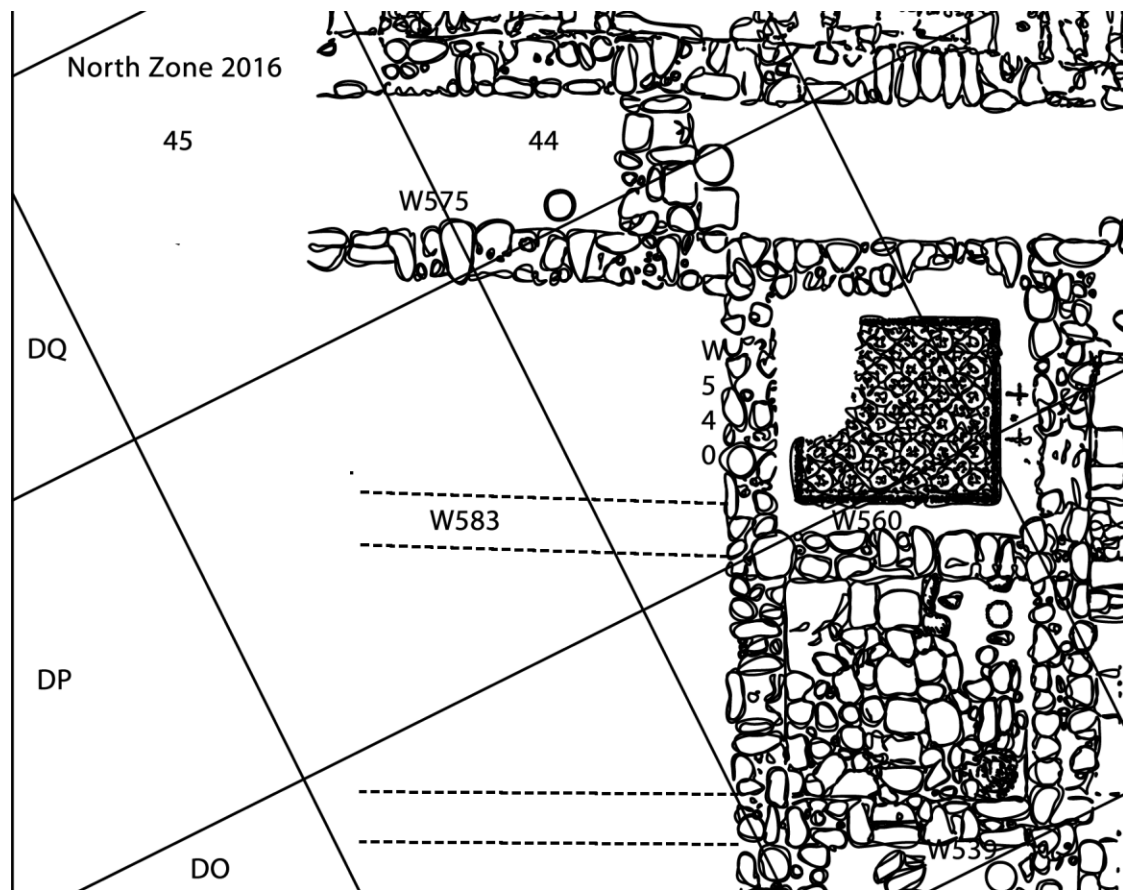

1. Continued work in DP44
 - a. Goal = discover form and function of building north of the NEC
 - b. Basket = 3429 and 3431
 - c. Starting elevation = 130.76
 - d. Ending elevation = 130.07
 - e. Soil = soil change after an hour of work
 - f. Comments
 - New locus 2145 with soil change
 - Approaching floor level
 - Evidence of mosaic in SE corner (previously exposed) (new locus F2146)

- Stopped with about 10 cm above floor
- Opened south part of next square to the north

- l. Comments
 - i. Broke surface

2. Continued work in DR40

- a. Goal = complete the excavation of the easterly storage room, east of the window wall W2132.
- b. Basket = 3430
- c. Starting elevation = 132.40

- d. Ending elevation = 131.82
- e. Soil = destruction fill
- f. Comments
 - i. Leveling to level of last year
 - ii. Will sub divide remaining section to make removal possible
 - iii. Changed removal route and established a new dump pile to the north
 - iv. Moved large slabs to lower level for rebuilding.
