1. Continued work in DP44

- a. Goal = discover form and function of building north of the NEC
- b. Basket = 3433 and 3435
- c. Starting elevation = 130.46
- d. Ending elevation = 130.03
- e. Soil = soil change above the floor
- f. Comments
 - New locus 2146 with soil change
 - Some stones seem to penetrate below the level of the floor [later discovered we had misidentified a floor level]
 - Recovered a 64 cm x 21 cm roof roller (Item # 810)

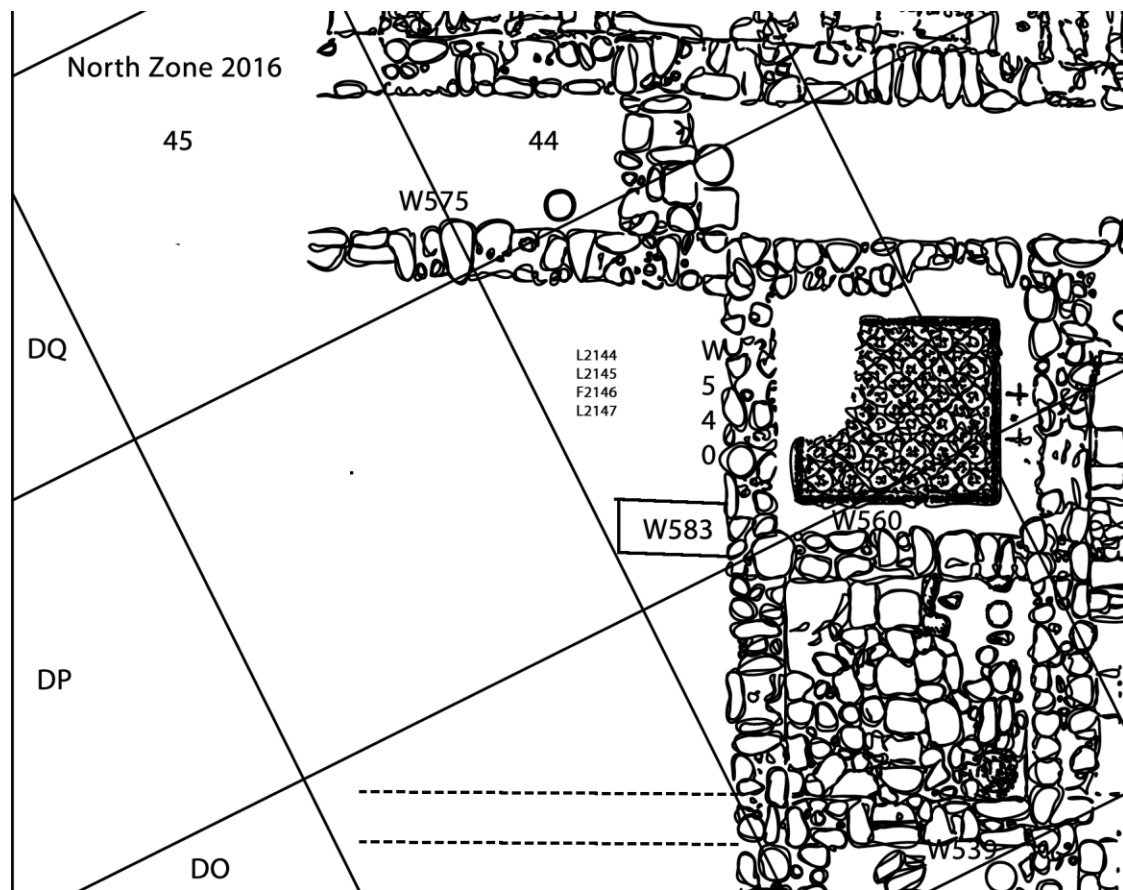

 - ii. Typical destruction fill

- a. Goal = complete the excavation of the easterly storage room, east of the window wall W2132.
- b. Basket = 3432 and 3436
- c. Starting elevation = 131.82
- d. Ending elevation = 131.33
- e. Soil = destruction fill
- f. Comments
 - i. Excavated to the level of the top of the base of the window wall
 - ii. Changed loci with the discovery of a cluster of crushed pots in the sw section of the excavation area. Pots were layered suggesting disposal of broken pots
 - iii. Wall shows weakness in the corner
 - iv. At least four phases in the wall
 - v. Recovered a bent door nail (Item #811)
