 - a. Goal = discover form and function of building north of the NEC
 - b. Basket = 3452 and 3453
 - c. Starting elevation = 130.73
 - d. Ending elevation = 130.29
 - e. Soil = Subsoil
 - f. Comments
 - i. Not yet reached the base of W541 as it runs parallel to W540 toward the piaster of W583
 - ii. Exposed the top of W2154 across the length of the excavation area at elevation 130.53
 - iii. We are exploring the possibility that the area between W2154 and W575 was an outdoor courtyard, especially as the space does not have an obvious means for maintaining a roof.

iv. 7 cm nail in SW corner of DO45 (#835)

v. A second nail fragment was found 20 cm below at 130.10 (#836)

- h. Basket = 3454, 3456, 3455, and 3457
- i. Starting elevation = 130.97
- j. Ending elevation = 130.37 north of the wall, 130.13 south of the wall
- k. Soil = top soil and sub soil
- l. Comments
 - i. Discovered and east to west wall (W2156) running parallel to W540 at elevation 130.79 and 2.7m from W540
 - ii. There may be a bench on the south side of the wall
 - iii. A catch basin for roof water is on the east side of W2153 next to WXXXX
 - iv. A unique top for a jar was recovered from the top of the bench
 - v. Several pieces of window glass were found in the fill
