

 Removed debris from within the church. Clear pieces of W510 may be appearing. A carefully worked limestone cornice (042) stands on end in the debris next to the wall. Perhaps at a higher level the wall had a decorative cornice.

Observations

Destruction fill is similar in both squares. However, the blocks in B1 fell in parallel to the southwest, on a somewhat similar line to the fall of the pillars in the cathedral. The church does not display the heavy destruction of the cathedral or the NWC. Perhaps it was already in disrepair in the 8th century. The earthquake then would have done additional damage to the NEC.
