- Removed the last of the destruction fill from F516. Thoroughly cleaned B1, B2, and A2
- In the NE corner of B1, one or two floor pieces are missing. The void revealed plaster against the north wall (W521) under the floor level. This is another confirmation that F516 comes from a second phase in the life of the church.
- Most tiles are missing in B2. In one section, a double ring of dark stone is of interest – perhaps decorative, perhaps worthy of investigation for a reliquary
- A rectangular stone on its side was revealed below floor level on the east/west axis of the church.
- Re-opened Square B3
 - Starting elevation = 131.23
 - \circ Ending elevation = 130.93
 - Removed back fill from previous year and cleaned the tomb area.
- Finished final cleaning and sweeping of C3


