Chronology of Excavation

13 July

- In Square B1
 - A separate locus was assigned to the corner as it showed no signs of being a loculus for a reliquary
 - A floor tile was reached some 17 CM down (F517?), so the area seems to be fill where a corner tile was dislodged.
