#### **General Description and Soil Analysis**

Soil in L529 is redder than others cited and compacted. It underlays the plaster base of F516.

## **Chronology of Excavation**

20 July

- In Square B3
  - Starting elevation = 130.93
  - Ending elevation = 130.73 (in parts)
  - In L529 under F516 removed plaster and stone base. Then began to remove dirt fill to F517. Many triangular marble stone and other marble fragments were in the fill.

#### 21 July

- In Square B3
  - Starting elevation = 130.88
  - o Ending elevation = 130.78
  - Cleared L529 to the level of the plaster of F517. Revealed a small section of mosaic approximately 1m east to west and 20-34cm north to south next to W510 beginning 0.9m from the interior SE corner. Level is 130.78
  - Removed and number .5m of the tiles of F516 on the north side of the sarcophagus.
