The north line of the opening was plastered vertically . . . running east/west. Could this plaster have joined with the plaster that originally sealed the tomb? So, the foundation for the first building was bounded on the north by the line of the stylobate, on the east by the line of the apse, and on the west by the chancel screen base. The latter was not plastered, so the chancel screen base may have cut the line, even as the stones for F517 cut the plaster.
