- Continued work in Square B4
 - Starting elevation = 132.71
 - Ending elevation = 132.15
 - Soil is Horizon A
 - Wall emerging to the south. There is significant rock fall in the NE corner of the square.

- Continued work in Square D0
 - Starting elevation = 131.14
 - Ending elevation = 130.58
 - Soil is Horizon C
 - Cleared to the level of the first stair.
 - The staircase is entirely exposed. It is one unit through the column. Whether the easterly column was part of the staircase is unclear. (Signs of the staircase to the east of W539 support inclusion of the latter column in the staircase.)
 - Opposite the staircase next to the north wall (W540) is an installation of some sort. It curves out from the wall about 60cm and is about 140 cm long. Perhaps it is a feed box (supporting the idea of domestic usage of the space in a later phase?).
