- Continued work in Square E2
  - Starting elevation = 130.60 and 130.32 in probe
  - Ending elevation = 130.36 and 130.11 in probe
  - Soil is Horizon B/C
  - o Leveled rest of the square
  - Dug probe deeper through hard plaster/mud to what seems like the stone base for a floor. As the probe is small, the level of stones could also be the top of a wide wall running to the west.
  - Ceased work at this point for the season.
- Conservation
  - Used sand to fill lacunae in floor in B0, as there was insufficient time to repair the floor.
  - In B4, conserved the edge of the remaining plaster near the doorway, filled two of the deeper holes in the floor, and repaired the plaster around the base of the cistern
  - IN the nave, continued to shore up edges of the fragmented mosaic floor.
    Cleaning of the Avi-Yonah pattern B8 continued
  - o Lowered and repaired a column drum in the center of the atrium
  - Cleaned loose rubble from the tops of the walls.
