

- Continued conservation work in Square C/D2 (Nave)
  - o Cleaning of nave continued.
  - Most fragments to the east in the geometric patterns are from the top floor (F589). So are those on the west end. In the center are those of F544.
- Continued work in Square D4
  - Starting elevation = 131.545 (south of W1201); 131.145 (north of W1201)
  - o Ending elevation = 130.980 (north of W1201)
  - o Soil is Horizon B
  - Worked only the area between W1201 and W510.
  - o Pottery frequency is increasing.
- Continued work in Square E5
  - Starting elevation = 130.584 (street north end); 131.389 (street south end);
    130.771 (trench south of W569); 131.415 (top of W569)
  - o 130.892 (trench south of W569); 130.892 (threshold)
  - Soil is Horizon B
  - Discovered a threshold of a door in limestone to the south of W569 angling to the west. It suggests a building of poorer quality than the building to the north
- Continued work in Square F4
  - Starting elevation = 130.425 (stone floor F571); 130.794 (west of W591)
  - Ending elevation = 130.774 (south east section, plaster floor); 130.470 (west of W591)
  - o Soil is Horizon B
  - Began removing the crater west of W591

- o There are at least two pots inside of it.
- A partially intact egg shell was recovered inside the pots.
- Continued work in square F3
  - Starting elevation = 131.444 (W574); 131.070 (south section); 130.960 (north section)
  - o Ending elevation = 130.904 (south section); 130.862 (north section)
  - Soil is Horizon A
  - W591 and W574 are quite clear. The NW corner of these two walls suffered significant degradation.
  - o A possible wall runs North/south from W574
- Continued work on cistern D in Square B4
  - Starting elevation = 128.441 (reference point 131.061)
  - Ending elevation = 128.40
  - Soil is silt left from usage of cistern.
  - A high volume of tesserae was recovered; no potsherds.
- Began work on Square E8
  - Starting elevation = 130.937
  - Ending elevation = 130.563
  - o Soil is Horizon A.
  - Removed surface fill.
